The Institution has facilities and initiatives for Alternate sources of energy and energy conservation measures, Management of the various types of degradable and nondegradable waste, Water conservation,Green campus initiatives and Disabled-friendly / barrier free environment during the last five year

- LED Bulbs and LED Tube lights are used in all the departments and the office of the College.
- Presently the college has two solar panels, one of 5 KV and another of 3 KV.
- The college has two generators of 25 KV and 30 KV through which electricity is supplied to all the departments, classrooms, library and office of the college.
- Degradable and non degradable wastes are kept separately in the college and a compost pit is used for degradable waste.
- Separate dustbins for degradable and non degradable wastes are kept at various places in the college campus.
- Degradable solid waste collected from dustbins is disposed in a compost pit where it gets converted in to manure.
- The non-degradable solid waste collected from dustbins is deposited in a large dustbin kept at a place outside the college, from where it is picked up by the municipal garbage collection vehicles.
- The college has an underground chemical waste absorbent pit, which helps in protecting the open ground and water resources from contamination by harmful chemicals.
- The scrapped material is sold to venders.
- Various programmes are organized in the college for waste management by NSS, NCC, Rovers-Rangers and various other departments.

- The college has a huge water tank of 58000 litres, which supplies water to the drinking water tanks and washroom tanks located at various places in the college campus.
- Single use plastic is prohibited in college campus. Various programmes are conducted by Environmental Cell and various departments of the college to prevent single use plastic.
- The college is surrounded by Rajaji National Park and is full of Natural beauty. A large number of Trees have been planted within the college campus.
- A forest of teak trees stretches far and wide outside the boundaries of the college.
- From time to time cleanliness, plantation, conservation of Trees and other awareness programmes are conducted in the college through NSS, NCC, Rovers/Rangers and other departments.
- A Botanical Garden has been developed in the college, having more than 40 species of ornamental plants, medicinal plants and horticultural plants like Rudraksh ((Elaeocarpus ganitrus), Chandan (Santalum album), Parijat (Nyctanthes arbortristis), Aawala (Phyllanthus amblica), Aaru (Prunus persica), Bel (Aegle marmelos), Harre (Terminalia chebula), Neem (Azadirachta indica), Diesel plant(Jatropha curcas), Chakotara (Citrus limon), Mango (Mangifera indica) etc. as medicinal plants Some well known ornamental plants grown in the garden are Araucaria, Tecoma, Almanda, Plumeria, Jadminum, Mussaenda, Nerium, Pinus, Canna, Thuja, Duranta. These plants are beneficial to students as well as staff for studies of Taxonomy, Anatomy, Embryology, Ecology and Conservational Biology.
- The college campus is disabled friendly. The college has facilities of wheel chairs, sign posts and tactical paths, ramps & lift for easy access to classrooms. The college has disabled friendly washrooms and scribes can be provided for writing papers in examination.
