Question 1- Teachers provide information about competitive exams to students and tell them how to prepare for such competitive exams.


Analysis: More than $53 \%$ of students strongly agree that teachers provide information about competitive exams to students and tell them how to prepare for such competitive exams while about $24.01 \%$ of students agree with the same. There is a small percentage of students who do not agree with the statement, this is a good response.
Question 2- College emphasis on developing occupational competence.


Analysis: More than 42.76 \% of students agree that the college emphasis on developing occupational competence, while around $31.77 \%$ of students strongly agree with the same. For the rest of the students who do not agree with this statement, the college will find out those reasons and try to remove them.

Question 3- Students can freely discuss their career plans and ambitions with a faculty member.


Analysis: More than 56.57 \% of students agree students can freely discuss their career plans and ambitions with a faculty member while about $15.55 \%$ of students strongly agree with the same. For the rest of the students who do not agree with this statement, the college will find out those reasons and try to remove them.

Question 4- The teacher is interested in and enthusiastic about teaching the class.


Analysis: More than 42.63\% of students strongly agree that teacher is interested in and enthusiastic about teaching the class while about $41.96 \%$ of students agree with the same, this is good feedback.

Question 5-Are other co-curricular organized from time to time in the college?


Analysis: More than 15.42 \% of students strongly agree that the other co-curricular organized from time to time in the college while about $40.35 \%$ of students agree with the same, this is a good response.
Question 6- The teacher is always ready to solve the subject-related problems of the students even outside the class.


Analysis: About $83 \%$ of the students are satisfied that the teacher is always ready to solve the subject-related problems of the students even outside the class, this is a good response.

Question 7- The teacher encourages the students to move forward in the future.

Question 9- You are happy and proud to be a part of this college.


Analysis: More than 33.24 \% of students agree that they are happy and proud to be a part of this college, while around $30.83 \%$ of students strongly agree with the same. For the rest of the students who do not agree with this statement, the college will find out those reasons and try to remove them.
Question 10- The teacher maintains enough discipline so the students can learn from it.


Analysis: More than 47.98 \% of students agree that the teacher maintains enough discipline so the students can learn from it while about $26.41 \%$ of students strongly agree with the same. For the rest of the students who do not agree with this statement, the college will find out those reasons and try to remove them.
