## ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Dr.P.D.B.H.Govt. PG. College, Kotdwar is a premier college in the entire Garhwal with a prestigious heritage and highest academic standards, diverse academic programs, distinguished faculty, various co-curricular activities, and modern infrastructure in the entire Uttarakhand. Dr.P.D.B.H.Govt. PG. College, Kotdwar was established in July 1971 by theGovernment of Uttar Pradesh.

The college has now different departments offering Under Graduate and Post Graduate courses in four faculties of Arts, Commerce, Science, and Education. The college volunteered for institutional accreditation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore, and got a 'B' grade. The college was started with the aim of imparting higher education to the poor students of the surrounding backward hilly area. Being a multi-faculty college, it provides knowledge and skill through various academic and Professional programs to shape the students as sensitive and responsible citizens. Further, the college has introduced a three-year degree course in B.Sc. Biotechnology. Feedback is an essential element of the learning process. The college collects the feedback on various curriculum aspects and courses from different stakeholders such as the student and faculty using structured Performa through manual mode. Total 867 Students participated in the process of this Feedback.

Question 1- College emphasis on developing professional competence.


Analysis: More than 52 \% of students agree that college emphasis on developing professional competence while about $13.49 \%$ of students strongly agree with the same. For the rest of the students who do not agree with this statement, the college will find out those reasons and try to remove them.

Question 2- Quality of teaching is excellent?


Analysis: More than $42.21 \%$ of students agree that the Quality of teaching is excellent, while around $31.72 \%$ of students strongly agree with the same. There is a small percentage of students who do not agree with the statement.

Question 3- The professors have proper knowledge of their subjects.


Analysis: More than $45 \%$ of students strongly agree professors have proper knowledge of their subjects while about $31.6 \%$ of students agree with the same, so we can conclude it is a good response.

Question 4- Do you feel that you are in a safe environment?


Analysis: More than $23.8 \%$ of students strongly agree that college provides a safe environment while about $39.33 \%$ of students agree with the same, this is good feedback.

Question 5- The Professors have enough interaction with all Students.


Analysis: More than 31.6 \% of students strongly agree that Professors have enough interaction with all Students while about 47.52 \% of students agree with the same, this is a good response.

Question 6- The library is used as a quiet place to study in college.


Analysis: About $35 \%$ of the students are satisfied that studies can be done in the library in a quiet environment, but for those students who do not agree, the college will try to make arrangements for a quieter environment in the library.

Question 7- Encouragement is provided for research and publication in the college.


Analysis: Approximately 69 \% of students are satisfied with the research and publication opportunities in the college.

Question 8- The teacher is always ready to solve subject-related problems.


Analysis: More than $36 \%$ of students strongly agree that the teacher is always ready to solve subject-related problems while about $47 \%$ of students agree with the same, this is a good response.

Question 9- The teacher encourages the students to think about the future


Analysis: More than $60 \%$ of students agree with the statement while about $8 \%$ of students do agree with the same, this is a good response.

Question 10- Are cultural or social programs organized from time to time in the college?


Analysis: More than $48 \%$ of students agree that cultural or social programs organized from time to time in the college while about $26 \%$ of students strongly agree with the same. For the rest of the students who do not agree with this statement, the college will find out those reasons and try to remove them.

Question 11- The teacher maintains enough discipline so the students can learn from it.


Analysis: More than 40 \% of students agree that the teacher maintains enough discipline so the students can learn from it while about $37.6 \%$ of students strongly agree with the same. For the rest of the students who do not agree with this statement, the college will find out those reasons and try to remove them.

Question 12- You are happy and proud to be a part of this college.


Analysis: More than 34.37 \% of students agree that they are happy and proud to be a part of this college, while around $27.8 \%$ of students strongly agree with the same. For the rest of the students who do not agree with this statement, the college will find out those reasons and try to remove them.
